EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The LIGHT (Lifting Individuals Giving Hope Today) Program aims to leverage City contracts to provide more job opportunities on City construction projects for the City's local workers by interceding on their behalf through monitoring City contracts for compliance. The program hopes to galvanize the City by making every contractor accountable in how they will achieve their local hire goals of 30% Local Hire; 20% Apprenticeship participation; and 10% Disadvantaged worker participation.

The Mayor's fiscal year 2008-09 Budget Summary stated that one of its core missions was to invest in job training and workforce development:

“To alleviate poverty by developing more and higher quality jobs that next year will facilitate entry into the workforce for 20,000 area residents and create training opportunities where people need opportunity the most...”

The LIGHT Program has been and continues to be in the forefront of making sure that the Department of Public Works (DPW) embraces each and every opportunity available to make this core mission a reality in the City of Los Angeles.

In this challenging job environment, the LIGHT Program has to be even more vigilant in its efforts of:

- 1) Ensuring local hire compliance and accountability from all contractors;
- 2) Increasing opportunities by requiring more City construction projects have local hire goals;
- 3) Strengthening our strategic partnerships even more with other City departments and agencies, contractors, building trades, community and faith based organizations.

With compliance and accountability comes opportunity.

PROJECT SUMMARIES

As of July 2008 there were seven (7) active Public Works construction projects under a Project Labor Agreement (PLA). In August 2008, two ATSAC (Automated Traffic and Surveillance Control) system construction projects were awarded, bringing the total to nine (9) active Public Works projects under a PLA. Combined these nine construction projects have a construction value of \$516 million:

- 1) Avenue 45/Arroyo Drive Sewer Relief
(19% Complete)
- 2) Fire Station No. 64
(82% Complete)
- 3) Harbor Replacement Police Station
(98% Complete)
- 4) Hollenbeck Police Station
(97% Complete)
- 5) Metro Detention Center
(90% Complete)
- 6) Police Administration Building
(80% Complete)
- 7) Police Administration Parking
(18% Complete)
- 8) North Hollywood ATSAC System Phase I
(5% Complete)
- 9) Hyde Park ATSAC System
(6% Complete)

At least three (3) of these projects are at or above 90% completion. As a result of this, the City may see a significant reduction of the local hire worker hours as these projects wind down. To increase opportunities though, the Board of Public Works is in the process of awarding more ATSAC system projects these coming months. All these projects are under a PLA with local hire goals.

The FY 2007 4th Quarter total for non-local journey person (JP) hours and non-local apprentice hours (as a percentage of total hours worked) for the 7 active projects stood at 66.67%. While the local JP and local apprentice hours were at 33.33%.

For 1st Quarter FY 2008-09, the non-local JP and non-local apprentice hours (for the same 7 active projects) saw an decrease of 0.10% to 66.57%. The local JP and local apprentice hours also saw an increase of 0.10% to 33.43%.

The two (2) ATSAC system projects in the 1st Quarter of FY 2008-09 added 6,270 and 3,197 hours to the non-local and local worker hours respectively. This led to a decrease in the non-local worker percentage to 66.57% and slight increase in the local worker percentage to 33.43%.

However, as previously discussed, the City may begin to see a drop across the board in terms of non-local and local hire worker hours as the aforementioned projects over 90% completion begin to wind down. It is the Bureau's intent with the anticipated awarding of more ATSAC system projects, to pro-actively work with its strategic partners to maximize the local and apprenticeship hiring opportunities these projects will present.

APPRENTICE UTILIZATION

In the 3rd Quarter LIGHT Report for fiscal year 2007-08, the City had conducted a Concentrated Poverty and Construction study through the Economic Roundtable of Los Angeles. Some of the issues of concern:

- 1) Construction is a large industry that provides five (5) percent of the jobs in Los Angeles;
- 2) Economic benefits from 3,000 construction jobs in LA County are being exported to other regions;
- 3) Concentrated poverty neighborhoods have a strong labor force base for utilizing construction employment opportunities.

The Bureau of Contract Administration (BCA) through the 30% local hire requirements of the PLA and the State mandated 20% utilization of apprentices on public works projects, monitors to ensure that contractors working on its projects meet these requirements and mandates.

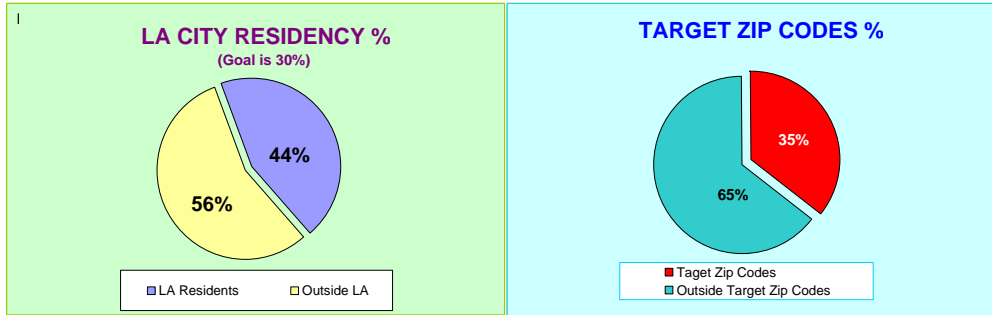
In the 1st Quarter of FY 2007, the DPW had five (5) active PLA projects. The total hours worked by both local and non-local apprentices were 120,287 hours. The local apprenticeship utilization percentage (in terms of total apprentice hours worked) was 41.34% or 49,728 hours.

In the first quarter of FY 2008 on these same five (5) PLA projects, the apprentice hours worked totaled 415,983. The local apprenticeship utilization percentage (in terms of total apprentice hours) was 41.95% or 174,523 hours. An improvement of 0.61% local apprentice utilization.

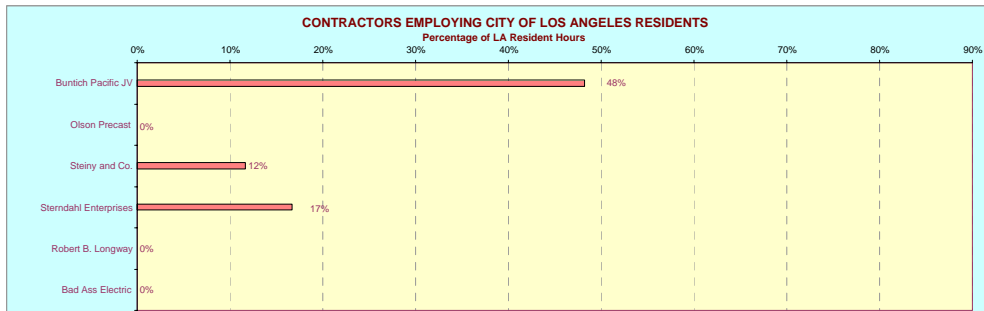
In that time period, four (4) additional Public Works projects with a PLA were awarded. These 4 projects provided an additional 12,208 total apprentice worker hours. Of these additional apprentice hours, local apprentice utilization percentage was 53.27% or 6503 hours.

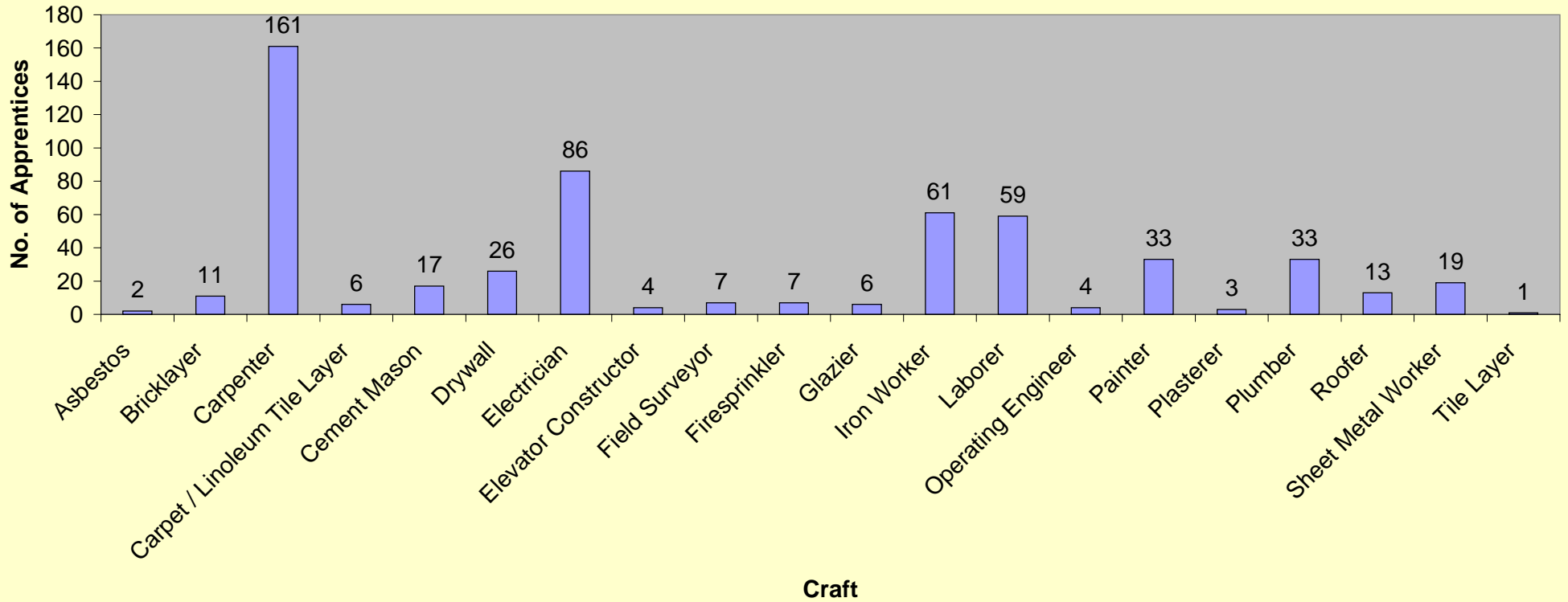

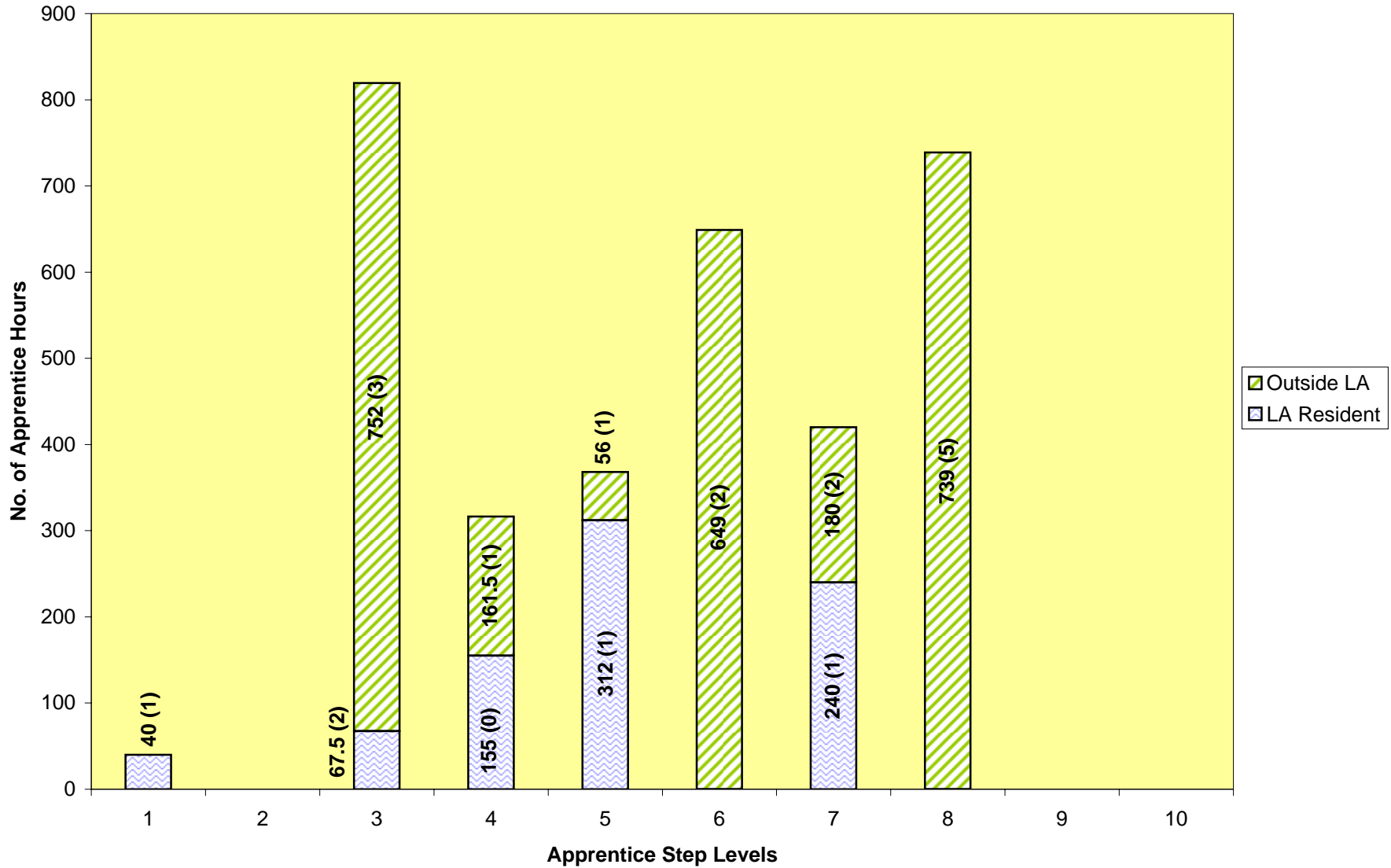

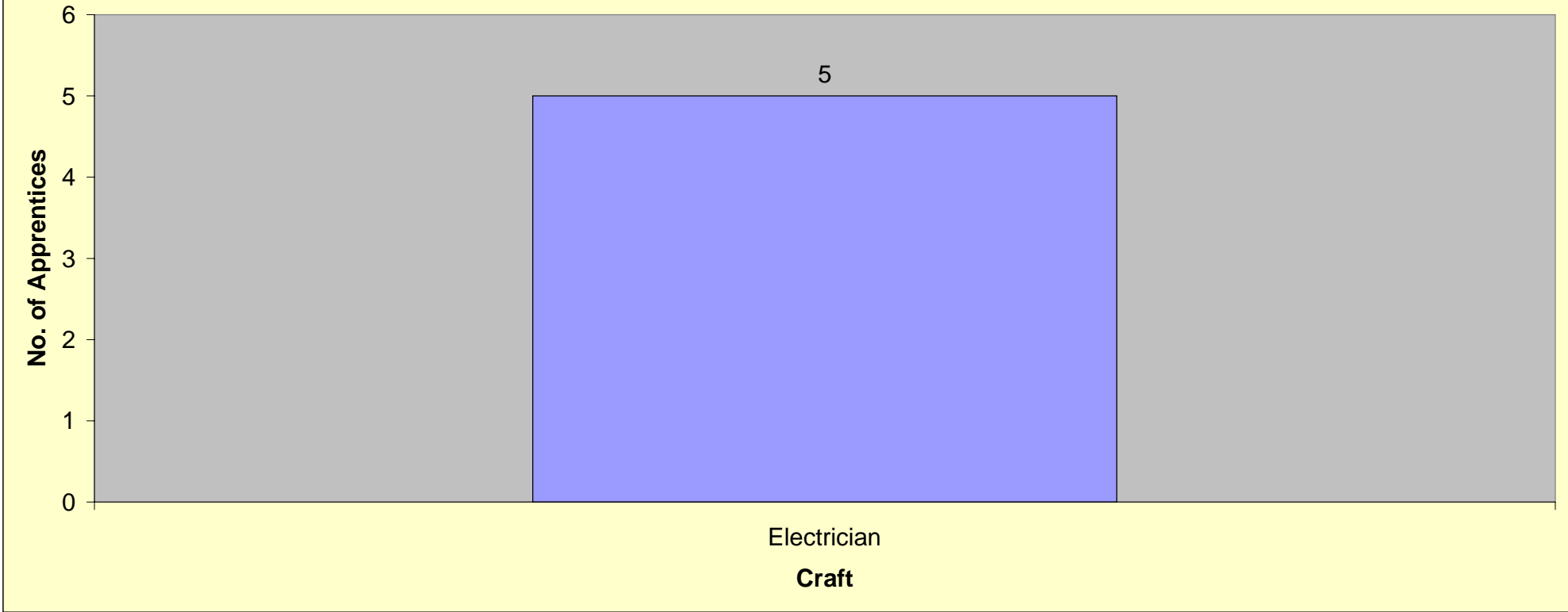
